DECISION:

Changes to April 2002 Regulatory Agenda

Page 3: Insert another line reflecting that the public meeting will be held on both June 18 and 19, 2002.

Page 19: In the abstract, delete the language beginning "He notes that the Commission's" and ending "remains after a mattress fire." In the final sentence of the abstract, insert: (1) after "FP 00-1" the following language "(requesting that the Commission adopt a standard similar to California TB 117)"; (2) after "FP 00-2" the following language "(requesting that the Commission adopt a standard similar to British Standard 5852)"; (3) after "FP 00-3" the following language "(requesting that the Commission require a warning label)" and (4) after "FP 00-4" the following language "(requesting that the Commission require a permanent identification tag.)"

Page 21: Insert the word "deny" in the last sentence between the words "to" and "the." Delete the word "Decision" in the last line of the Timetable section and add the words "Voted to Deny Petition" after the word "Commission."

Page 29: Revise the last sentence of the abstract to read: "On November 1, 2001, the Commission granted the petition insofar as it pertained to the smaller model rocket car that the petitioner proposed to market, but denied the petition insofar as it pertained to the larger model rocket car that the petitioner proposed to market."

Page 35: Add the following language at the end of the Abstract section: "The Commission has been considering how best to improve the effectiveness of recalls. That effort has included meetings on the use of credit card and electronic databases and will include additional meetings on measures of recall effectiveness and how best to improve the response and return rates of the recalls that the Commission conducts."
