**[PROPOSED] ORDER ON COMPLAINT COUNSEL’S MOTION IN LIMINE TO EXCLUDE PUBLIC OPINION POLLS COMMISSIONED BY RESPONDENT**

Complaint Counsel has moved pursuant to 16 C.F.R. §1025.23 to exclude two public opinion polls regarding small rare earth magnets that Respondent Zen Magnets has listed as part of its evidence in this action. The polls are a July 2013 telephone poll conducted by Public Policy Polling and a July 2014 Google Consumer Survey.

Upon review of the motion and Respondent Zen Magnets’ response, the Court finds that the cited polls are irrelevant to the issues to be addressed in this action, and hereby GRANTS Complaint Counsel’s Motion In Limine to Exclude Public Opinion Polls Commissioned by Respondent.
